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Health Services Program



The goal of the Health Services Program is to strengthen the educational process thorough health supervision and health education of children and youth.

CHOOSE FROM THREE TYPES OF NURSING CAREERS WITH THE ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT:

School Nurse

- School nurses support student learning, promote health and wellness for an entire school.
- Nursing services including screenings, treatments, medication, diabetes and seizure management, health counseling, linkage with community providers, health promotion, and injury and disease prevention education.
- Actively assists in identifying students with disabilities and participates on multidisciplinary educational teams.
- Interprets student's health history and develops a plan for those with health needs.
- Member of the AEA bargaining group (certificated position)

School nurse requirements

- Current Alaska RN licensure
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Two years nursing experience, assessment and referral skills
- Type C certificate, Alaska Dept. of Education

Health Treatment Nurse

- Provides individualized skilled nursing procedures and medically related services as prescribed.
- Assesses health needs of students with disabilities and develops plans of care in collaboration with school nurse, parent, and physician.
- Treatments include: tube feedings, tracheostomy care, catheterizations, respiratory assistance, ventilator management and medical support systems management.
- Care and management of medically fragile and technology dependent students.
- Member of ACE bargaining group (classified position)

Health treatment nurse requirements

- Current Alaska RN licensure
- ADN, BSN, Diploma
- Acute care experience
- Medical technology experience for students with disabilities
- Flexible

Substitute Nurse

- Daily assessment and treatment of students in absence of school nurse or health treatment nurse.
- Provide emergency student health care.
- Manage student health records.
- Delivery of medications to students with orders from medical care provider.
- Completion of "Summary of Services Provided" form to promote continuity of care in absence of regular school nurse or health treatment nurse and to facilitate communication.
- No bargaining group

Substitute nurse requirements

- Current Alaska RN licensure
- Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Complete ASD substitute nurse orientation to programs used for health records management
- Complete ASD substitute nurse orientation to school nursing and technology used for students with health concerns or treatments
