Parents—teach kids to Be KidSafe when riding school buses:

- Be safe and considerate of others
- Don't push, crowd, or disturb others walking to, waiting for, or riding the bus



- Stay a safe distance from the roadway
- Stay out of the way of traffic
- Stay clear of wheels
- Wait for the bus driver to give permission to cross the street in front of the bus

Riding the bus:

- Follow directions of the bus driver
- Don't interfere with the bus driver
- Keep head, arms, legs and body inside the bus
- Don't open windows without the bus driver's permission
- Don't throw objects inside or outside of the bus
