SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE OF CONTINUATION GRANT AWARD: HIV
PREVENTION RARE-T

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept the HIV/AIDS Prevention RARE-T Continuation Grant from the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services in the amount of \$20,810.

PERTINENT FACTS:

The Anchorage School District's Health and Physical Education Program submitted a proposal this spring to the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services to provide continued support for the District's Reduce AIDS Risk Effectively in Teens (RARE-T) HIV/AIDS peer education project.

The grant award supports on-going training of students and advisors; dissemination of the program through classroom peer presentations; release time for advisors to attend presentations; and the development of health promotion materials.
