SUBJECT: CRAYOLA DREAM-MAKERS RECIPIENTS

PERTINENT FACTS:

Twenty years ago the Crayola Dream-Makers Award program was introduced to encourage the creativity and conceptual development of kindergarten through sixth-grade children through art activities emphasizing the value of visual learning in all curricular areas, and calling attention to the creative work of children through exhibitions of their artwork. The theme for the 2004 Dream-Makers competition was "*Dreaming Beyond the Book.*" Artwork submissions reflected this theme and were judged on the basis of visual appeal, originality and craftsmanship.

Seven elementary students from the Anchorage School District were among the 40 selected from the Western Region to receive awards. The winning students are Rachel Boeckman and Brenna Cranswick of Rabbit Creek; Andrew Tims of Fairview; Ashley Bravo and Erika Coker of Chester Valley; Anna Veelman formerly of O'Malley, and Krista Soderlund formerly of Turnagain Elementary.

These creative students received valuable guidance and support from art teachers Hollis Mitchell of Rabbit Creek and O'Malley, Sharon Merrell of Turnagain and Sharon Trager of Fairview Elementary.
