SUBJECT: DAVID WILKINSON'S SELECTION TO THE UNITED STATES  
SENATE YOUTH PROGRAM

PERTINENT FACTS:

Over 40 years ago the United States Senate voted to endorse a nationwide youth program that would bring high school students to Washington, D.C., for a brief on-site introduction to the functions of the federal government and the United States Senate.

Recently David Wilkinson, senior at Polaris K-12, was selected to attend the 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual William Randolph Hearst Foundation United States Senate Youth Program. He is one of 104 high school students nationwide who received the all-expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C. later this month. He will also be awarded a \$5,000 college scholarship while at the week-long program.

Student selection for the program is based solely on the outstanding ability and demonstrated qualities of leadership as elected or selected high school student officers of the 2004-2005 school year.

It is requested that the School Board recognize David Wilkinson for his selection to the 43<sup>rd</sup> Annual United States Senate Youth Program.
