RECOMMENDATION:

It is the Administration's recommendation that the School Board approve and authorize the Superintendent to accept nineteen grant awards from the Best Buy Corporation, in the form of gift cards, with a total value of \$47,500.

PERTINENT FACTS:

Best Buy's national Te@ch grant competition awards Best Buy gift cards valued at \$2,500 each to schools whose submissions describe the most innovative and effective project ideas for instructional technology. Nineteen ASD schools have won Te@ch awards this year. The schools are: Alaska State School for Deaf and Hard of Hearing; AVAIL, Mirror Lake and Romig middle schools; Muldoon, Nunaka Valley, Rabbit Creek, Bear Valley, Fire Lake, Homestead, Klatt, Russian Jack, Scenic Park, Spring Hill, Trailside, Turnagain, Ursa Minor, Willow Crest, and Wonder Park elementary schools. These schools will purchase such items as digital cameras, projectors, video equipment, software, and other peripherals and supplies.
