SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY FOR
JANUARY 31, 2005

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for January 31, 2005 is attached (Attachment A). The total active enrollment at the end of January was 49,223. This enrollment represents a decrease of 231 students when compared to the September 30, 2004 total of 49,454. The membership totals are compared in the following table:
