PERTINENT FACTS:

Dr. Mary DuHoux, school psychologist, and employee of the Anchorage School District since 1989, has been named 2005 Alaska School Psychologist of the Year by the Alaska School Psychologists Association.

Dr. DuHoux currently works at Bartlett High School and is co-advisor for their RARE-T (Reducing AIDS Risk Effectively in Teens) peer education group. Prior to joining the Bartlett staff, she worked at Dimond High School for 10 ½ years and has served a variety of elementary and middle schools. Dr. DuHoux has helped train six school psychology interns during her tenure.

Dr. DuHoux is well known throughout the district for her work in crisis intervention. She assisted the district's Psychology program develop its suicide intervention protocol and helps with suicide prevention in-services.
