SUBJECT: END-OF-MONTH MEMBERSHIP SUMMARY  
FOR MARCH 31, 2005

PERTINENT FACTS:

The end-of-month membership report for March 31, 2005 is attached (Attachment A). The total active enrollment at the end of March was 48,787. This enrollment represents a decrease of 667 students when compared to the September 30, 2004 total of 49,454. The membership totals are compared in the following table:
