## El Libro de Música Multimedia

1. You will be working with a classmate. After being divided into pairs, you will both decide on a

Spanish language song from the current years Latin Grammy nomination list that you would like to present in your Multimedia Music Book.
II. Decide who will fulfill these roles:
<u>Ingeniero</u> : Responsible for the Title slide & the Country slides.
Productor: Responsible for the Dedication slide & Biography slides.
<ul> <li>En Equipo: You are BOTH responsible for:</li> <li>o - the Song Summary slide (one sentence that summarizes the song).</li> <li>o - the Song slides (minimum of 15 slides).</li> <li>o - the Oral Presentation of your Music Book.</li> <li>o - the Favorite Lyrics slide (you each must have your own favorite!).</li> </ul>
III. Look for the "letras" (lyrics) of the song you have chosen on the Internet. We will only spend 4 days in class so use your time efficiently!!!
IV. In your Multimedia Music Book (Power Point), a power point template will be provided to help you organize your project but you need to include:
A title slide: the name of your song, the artist(s) of the song and the your names and roles played;
A <u>dedication slide</u> : A dedication in Spanish and the names of people who you would like to present this music book tomust be at least 25 words;
Biography slides: Information on your artists. Don't write tons of information on these slides. They should be prompts to help you remember what you are going to talk about. See rubric page for exact requirements.
Country slides: Information on the country or countries your artist or group is from. Include a map and flag. Don't write tons of boring information on these slides. Find some interesting and fun facts. Use prompts to help you remember what you are going to talk about.
Summary Slide: A simple summary of your song in Spanish. A couple of sentences explaining what the song is about is sufficient.
Song slides: A minimum of <b>15</b> slides with the following components: <ul> <li>Las Letras: the lyrics to your song spread out through the 15 slides in Spanish.</li> <li>El Interpretacion: photos, drawings and/or animations that explain the lyrics to the song.</li> </ul>
The Favorite Lyrics slide: Your favorite lines of the song (each of you).
V. To the class, give an oral presentation in Spanish (NO ENGLISH!!!) while sharing your Multimedia Music Book! Be sure to talk about your roles, your dedication, and about your artist and the country they come from! Include the song summary and why you liked your favorite lines!
