**I. Instrument** with case, all in working order

**2. Music folder** that can hold books for class and a practice sheet

Name on front in blue/black ink,

**3. Required music books**: Standard of Excellence, Book I (red)

Name on front in blue/black ink.

**4. Supplies** for each instrument as listed below:

**All Inst:** A pencil for class, and a music stand (for home use)

Flute: Cleaning/tuning rod, swab

**Clarinet:** AT LEAST FIVE REEDS, swab, cork grease, reed guard

**Oboe:** Same as Clarinet

**Saxophone:** Same as Clarinet, neck strap

**Brass:** (including Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, Tuba)

Valve oil, tuning/slide grease

Cleaning snake and mouthpiece brush at home.

**Trombone:** Same as brass, but add a small spray bottle and slide oil/cream

**Percussion:** At least one pair of #2B (standard) wooden drum sticks, at least

one pair of xylophone/bell mallets (hard rubber). Stick bag is

recommended but optional.

Bell set to start the year and a practice pad or snare drum to be

used at a later date after bells have been learned.
