4. Supplies for each instrument as listed below:

All Inst.: A pencil for class, and a music stand (for home use)

Flute: Cleaning/tuning rod, swab

Clarinet: AT LEAST FIVE REEDS, swab, cork grease, reed guard

Oboe: same as Clarinet, 3 reeds is fine

Saxophone: Same as Clarinet

Brass: (including Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, Tuba)

Valve oil, tuning/slide grease

Cleaning snake and mouthpiece brush at home.

Trombone: Same as brass, but add a small spray bottle and slide oil/cream

Percussion: Stick bag is required.

At least one pair of wooden drum sticks, at least one pair

of xylophone/bell mallets (hard rubber), one pair of soft cymbal mallets,

one pair general Timpani sticks

Percussionists will be using school equipment this year

(leave your drums at home!)
