



- 1 Your primary navigation is via the hamburger menu from the upper left. This icon will open the navigation menu from any place within the program.
- 2 Places
 - *ConnectED* takes you back to your student bookbag.
 - Resources provides access to videos, study materials, self-practice, and additional tools for every lesson.
 - Homework shows all assignments due and completed.
 - Home takes you back to your main page with your ebook.
 - Standards, Glossary, Notebook, and My Messages provide additional resources your teacher may use.
- 3 Your primary ebook is accessed by the “eBook” button.
- 4 *LearnSmart*® (LS) is an additional version of your ebook which provides a guided read, practice and personalized review plan.
- 5 Homework shows your upcoming assignments.
- 6 To get additional help, hit the profile icon and select “Help” to get additional support on using the platform.

The online student center can be accessed my most web-enabled devices. Some resources such as the eBook or *LearnSmart* may require an app to access on mobile devices such as phone or tablets. If an App is available for your device, you will see links both to the appropriate app store and links to login to the app on the bookbag page of *ConnectED*.

- When logged in, click on the book to get to the main menu.
- The “hamburger” menu is on the upper left corner. This allows you to access a huge amount of information!
- To get to your textbook, from the home menu, click on the “eBook” button on the right side of the page.

Navigating the eBook (at the top left of the window):

1. The “hamburger” menu is first. You can use this to navigate through the textbook.
2. Next is the highlighter pen. Click on it, select text and then you can select a color. You can undo this by clicking on the text you highlighted and then click on the trashcan.
3. The pen tool is next and can be used by clicking on it. There is an eraser on the menu bar when you click on the pen tool. You can also “clear all” marks made.
4. The last tool is the note. You can make a note anywhere on the page and type it in. It will appear as a yellow sticky on your page. When you click on the note, you can delete it by clicking on the trash can.
5. There is also a glossary, index and zoom button on this menu bar.
6. The bottom bar is a page view menu. You can click to see multiple pages or click the single page view to see only one page. If you click on the multiple pages button, you can type in the page you would like to navigate to.

Main Menu page:

Click on the blue menu bar that says “chapter 1” to expand the view. This will allow you to see all the chapters available and when you click on the chapter, it will show all the lessons and resources.
