
Autobiodoodle

Step 5 (Final Draft): Take a blank sheet of paper and use it like tracing paper. Place your rough draft underneath it and tape it. Where you see a solid line, use your vocabulary words instead. Every solid line you drew on your rough draft should be replaced with words from your vocabulary list on your final draft.

Hint: Students who are the most successful with this activity use gel pens or something like them. You will find colored pencils will work, but they will need to be very sharp for crisp, clear writing.

Think about your color choices to enhance your final product. These final projects will be publicly displayed, so make them appropriate and spell your words carefully.
