Sand Lake Orff/Choir Rules & Permission Slip

Overview:

Sand Lake offers both a Choir and an Orff Ensemble. These are voluntary extracurricular music activities open to anyone in grades 3-6 who is interested in singing or playing Orff instruments in a group performance setting.

Where & When:

Rehearsals are held in the music room (room 139). Orff will be held from 8:00am to 8:45am before school on Wednesday mornings beginning Sept. 7, 2011. Choir will be held from 8:00am to 8:45am before school on Thursday mornings beginning Sept. 8, 2011. We perform evening concerts at school, daytime school assemblies, Area Festivals, and in public community venues. Currently planned performance dates are attached, and more may occur if there is student interest, transportation, and chaperones available.

Concert dates are listed on the activities calendar on the school webpage. Concert dates will also be announced via letters home, Mrs. Nilsson's website, and in school newsletters.

Expectations:

All ensemble members will be expected to perform with the group in concerts. Choir members will be learning basics of singing technique, including breath control, vowel formation, blend, and voice care, and will be expected to memorize songs. Occasionally we may learn choreography and simple percussion accompaniment.

Orff ensemble members will be learning sticking techniques, instrument care, blend, and may be using more than one type of instrument. The material addressed may be slightly more advanced than the material introduced in general music class.

The Fine Print:

Permission slips must be signed by the student and the parent, and students should return them no later than September 16th. Rehearsals will continue running weekly before school until the end of April. Rehearsals will not be held on vacation days, standardized testing days, any holiday excluded from activities by ASD policy, or any time school is delayed or canceled due to inclement weather. These cancellations will be noted on the school's online activities calendar. Students may only miss 3 rehearsals in order to remain a member of the group. Exceptions will be made for major medical emergencies.

Summary of Group Rules:

Expectations for Choir/Orff members are as follows:

- Participants will attend rehearsals and perform with energy and enthusiasm.
- Rehearsals will follow school rules and consequences.
- Members will participate in all performances, including evening programs.
- Members will dress appropriately for performances (Sand Lake Music t-shirts and clean jeans), and behave well, because they are representing their school to the community of Anchorage.
