

Setting up ASD Exchange E-mail on iPhone:

Prerequisites: Your iPhone must already be activated through iTunes on the AT&T network.

Qualifiers:

The iPhone's current software significantly limits Exchange services and has tested unstable at times. This may improve when Version 2 is released (currently scheduled by Apple for June 2008).

First, you must be connected to the ASD network via Wi-Fi. The configuration may be done from school or work. Once you are configured, you may send/receive e-mail via any network. Testing the iPhone with ASD e-mail on AT&T's Edge network and out of district Wi-Fi worked intermittently.

If your iPhone gets lost or stolen and it has sensitive ASD data on it, IT can remotely delete everything on it (after Version 2 is released). Notify the ASD Help Desk.

Procedure: To connect to Wi-Fi (if you have not already done so):

- Tap Settings
- Tap Wi-Fi
- Slide the toggle switch to "On" if it is off.
- Choose your building Wi-Fi and tap in your Wi-Fi password if necessary. Continue to e-mail setup.

To set up e-mail:

- Open Settings then tap Mail (settings).
- Tap Add Account...
- Tap Microsoft Exchange
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- Fill in the following:
 - Name: lastname_firstname
 - Address: Your e-mail address (lastname_firstname@asdk12.org)
 - Domain: Optional
 - Under Server, Hostname: webmail.asdk12.org
 - Username: lastname_firstname@asdk12.org
 - Password: (Your e-mail password)
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- Go back to the main menu and click on Mail. You will see your newly added ASD account and you can send and receive mail.
